E. With reference to Messrs. Aitken and Murdoch's letter of the 2nd instant respecting the pumping arrangements in the Steamer "PATMOS" (now named "LORD BROUGHTON"), I have to inform you that these pumping arrangements will be approved in this instance.

It is concluded that air pipes are fitted to all ballast tanks in accordance with the requirements of the Rules, also that doubling plates are fitted under all sounding pipes, and that the after peak is not a ballast tank.

The plans forwarded are being returned to you under separate cover.
