This vessel was built under the supervision of the Surveyors to the Germanischer Lloyd, but is now under survey at Newcastle with a view to being classed by this Society.

The Surveyors have forwarded a plan of the pumping arrangements as now amended.

The size of the hold suction is slightly less than that required by the Rules, but might be accepted in this instance.

It is submitted that these pumping arrangements might be approved.

It is concluded that air pipes are fitted to all ballast tanks in accordance with the requirements of the Rules, also that doubling plates are fitted under all sounding pipes, and that the after peak is not a ballast tank.

The Newcastle Surveyors should be informed accordingly.
