In reply to your letter of the 16th instant, respecting the S.S. "PATMOS", the vessel is in dry dock and the floors are being dealt with as necessary, also stiffening fitted in No.1 tank.

I wrote to the Superintendent, Mr. Wawn, of Sunderland, stating that if was going to fit new cables they should be 240 fms. 1.13/16, but that he should make sure that the present windlass would take same.
