M. Dear Sirs,

With reference to Mr. Aitken's letter of the 1st instant respecting the S. S. "PATMOS" I have to acquaint you that the plans forwarded by you have been carefully examined and compared with the Rule requirements, and that provided the strengthening of the bottom forward and the margin connections at that part, the panting arrangements, tunnel, hatchways, and hatch coamings be found or made to your satisfaction, the scantlings and arrangements be in accordance with the plans now forwarded, the requirements of Section 48 of the Rules for vessels not built under Survey be complied with, and a favourable report be received from you on completion of the Survey, the vessel will be eligible to be classed 100A-.

I have also to state that provided the test Certificates of the anchors and cables are found to be in order, and the remainder of the equipment to be in accordance with or equivalent to the Rule requirements, the figure "1" will be assigned.

I shall be glad if you will be good enough to furnish all the particulars and measurements detailed on report form 11B for freeboard assignment, and forward the usual request form.

A plan of the boilers should be forwarded if obtainable, or if not, the scantlings should be reported on a First Entry Report form, and particulars of the engines and pumping arrangements should also be furnished.

The plans forwarded by you are returned herewith.
