Dear Sirs,

S. In confirmation of my telegram to-day, respecting the ex-German Steamer "PATMOS", I have to acquaint you that I am in receipt of a letter from the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle, in which they state that the vessel is under their inspection with a view to re-classification. They add they understand that the Board of Trade at your port has some of the plans etc., which they kept when assigning the freeboard.
