

Two Representatives of the Byron Steamship Co. have called this morning regarding the two steamers "PATMOS" and "ERIC PETERSEN" which this Company has purchased.

Mr. M. Embiricos, the Manager of the Company, is arranging to send the "PATMOS" on a voyage to the Near East with a general cargo, and he is anxious to obtain a continuance of the Certificate which has been issued by the Society while the vessel was in the hands of the Shipping Controller. The ship is urgently required, and there is no time at present to submit her for survey for classification, but he proposes to carry out a survey for classification as soon as it can be arranged.

The vessel is now in the Middle Dry Dock, Jarrow, Newcastle.

The circumstances in the case of the steamer "ERIC PETERSEN" are somewhat similar. It is proposed to reclass the steamer later on, and in the meantime, the Owners desire an extension of the Certificate previously issued to the Ministry of Shipping. This vessel is docking to-day in the Tyne.

The Owners have received a wire, copy of which is attached, from their Representative in the Tyne.
