Dear Sirs,

M. I duly received Mr. Vuijk's letter of the 5th instant regarding the equipment of chain cable supplied to the non-propelling barge "UNO" - Messrs. N.V. Scheepswerf v/h de Groot & van Vliet's Yard No. 219 - and his remarks have been noted.

In reply I am directed to state that to bring the weight of this equipment up to the requirements of the Rules it will be necessary to supply two additional 15 fathom lengths of  $\frac{7}{8}$ " diameter cable.

As this is a new vessel, the Owners' consent should be obtained to this proposal to supply two additional lengths of cable to compensate for the cable being supplied  $\frac{1}{16}$ " in diameter less than required by the Rules.
