Dear Sirs,

M. I return, under separate cover, one copy of the plan, forwarded with Mr. Lodder's letter of the 17th instant, of stern frame and rudder for Messrs. De Groot & Van Vliet's No. 219, and with regard thereto I have to state that the scantlings and arrangements as shewn and amended will be approved, provided they be carried out to your satisfaction.

On account of the rudder plate being welded on the outside edge only it is considered that intermediate diaphragms should be fitted as indicated on the plan. As in previous cases the Owners' consent should be obtained to the proposals to make the connection between the separate sections of the stern post by electric welding.

The duplicate copy of the plan is being retained for reference.
