We beg to inform you in reply to your Classing letter on the M/V "TENSAN MARU" that the thickness of the sheer strake and strake below at the ends of the vessel is as approved (i.e. .42" forward and aft), and the decks, tunnel and bulkheads have been tested as per Rule and found satisfactory.

The freeboard was not assigned by this Society, and therefore, it was not verified by us.

It is regretted that the above information was not supplied in our report.
