Dear Sir,

In reply to the inquiries in the
classing letter of the 23rd ultimo ^{regarding} items in the 1st Entry
report (Kobe No. 1601) upon the steamer "HARBIN MARU" I beg
to state as follows.

The 2nd deck beams in No. 1 hold are 10 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ x '48
channels spaced 49 inches.

The shelter deck sheerstrake is doubled with '68
plating for 32 feet at the ends of the bridge.

The forecastle deck is sheathed with 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " Oregon Pine
and the bridge and boat decks with 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " teak.

The boat deck beams are 6 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ x '40 not 6 x 3 x 40
as entered in the report.

The butts of the shelter deck stringer plates are
quadruple riveted for half length amidships clear of the
bridge.
