The Second Special Survey No.2 and the Boiler Survey became due in the case of the former vessel in November and October, 1937 respectively, and the Second Special Survey No.3, the Boiler Survey and the Screwshaft Survey became due in the latter case in March, April and May last respectively.

The Society's Surveyors at Leith now forward a letter, dated 1st instant, received from the Owner, in which it is stated that he no longer desires to maintain the classification of these trawlers with this Society.

The Classing Committee had the cases before them on Friday, 15th instant, when they decided to give instructions for the character of each vessel to be withdrawn from the Register Book and Three Dots (. . .) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owner's request.
