I have to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 27th October relative to the Boiler survey of the steamer "SEMIRAMIS".

Before receiving your letter, I had been advised that the boilers would be ready for survey at Palembang on the 5th instant. The nature and amount of work in hand at this port made it impracticable for me to carry out the survey personally at that time.

So that no inconvenience should be caused to the Owners of the vessel, I arranged for Mr. Anderson (Messrs. Ritchie & Bisset) to carry out the survey on behalf of Lloyd's Register and I advised the Asiatic Petroleum Company accordingly.

In the meantime, the Asiatic Petroleum Company had been in communication with their Principals in London and had decided to withdraw the vessel from Classification; their letter advising me of this fact is enclosed herewith.
