Nature of Survey

When due

The Boiler Survey became due at the end of July last.

The class is subject to the port outer plate (E.W.2,34) and shell plating and frames on port side in way of Engine Room (E.W.6,34 and doublings) and C3 plate from aft (p.s.) repaired by E.W.1,36, being specially examined at the next drydocking.

In reply to enquiry the Piraeus Surveyors now write enclosing a letter from the Ministry of Marine, Athens, to the effect that this vessel is now a unit of the Hellenic Royal Navy, and it is requested that the class may be withdrawn.

It is submitted the class of the vessel be withdrawn from the Register Book and Three Dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
