
The Boiler Survey of the "AXIOS" became due at the end of July last.

In the case of the "STRYMON" the Second Special Survey No.1, which became due in October, 1937 has been partly held, and the Boiler Survey became due in November of last year. Action has hitherto been deferred by the Classing Committee as the vessel has been laid up indefinitely.

These trawlers have recently been purchased by the Greek Government and, in reply to enquiry, the Piraeus Surveyors have forwarded a copy of a letter which they have received from the Ministry of Marine, Athens, requesting that their classes should be withdrawn, as they are now units of the Hellenic Royal Navy.

The year of grace in the case of the "STRYMON" expired in October last.

The Classing Committee had the cases before them on Friday, 2nd instant, when they decided to give instructions
