The Class of this vessel is subject to the starboard hawse pipe being specially examined or renewed at the next Annual Survey, and to 60 fathoms of chain cable being placed on board at the earliest opportunity.

In reply to enquiry regarding chain cable, the Principal Surveyor for the Far East now writes stating that the vessel underwent a Government Survey and extensive repairs, including damage repairs, when in drydock at Osaka from the end of July until the 14th ultimo. The Society's Surveyors were not called in and although repeated enquiries were made to the Owners regarding their intentions during and after this docking, no reply has been received.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Friday, the 23rd instant, when, having regard to the fact that the repairs referred to above had not been carried out under the supervision of the Society's Surveyors as required by the Rules, they decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be expunged from the Society's Register Book with a Red Line (—) indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
