In the first half of September a number of Swedish fishing vessels were reported to have struck mines off the Danish coast, and many mines were reported to have been seen off the Swedish west coast. The fishing boat *Neptun*, of Ockerö, was mined on Sept. 5, west of Hirtshals. The steam trawler *Viros*, of Gothenburg, was lost west of Hirtshals on the morning of Sept. 3. Another fishing vessel, which was fishing in the vicinity, heard explosions, as of mines, and the *Viros* had afterwards disappeared. Several other fishing vessels had gear damaged through catching mines in the waters near Hirtshals. The fishing boat *Beatrice*, of Styrsö, was fishing about 30 miles E.N.E. of the German minefield when she was repeatedly attacked by two German aircraft which machine-gunned her.
