I duly received your letter of the 4th instant, forwarding a plan, in duplicate, of Hartman Extractor for whaling factory, proposed by Messrs. A.-B. Gotaverken for the s.s. "FRATERNITAS", and I have to inform you that this plan will be approved for a working pressure of 70 lb. per square inch, provided the thickness of the dished ends be not less than 16.5 mm., the welding of the flange to the dished end plate be carried out as now amended on the plan, the shell plate be adequately compensated in way of the large branches at the top, and the whole of the work be carried out under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

I may add that the Firm's proposal regarding the compensation of the holes in the shell should be submitted for consideration.

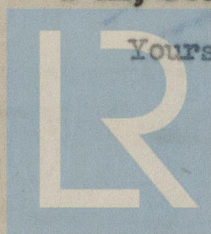
