
Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "FRATERNITAS", I beg to remind you that the year of grace allowed for the completion of the Special Survey No.1 expired at the end of last month but the survey has not yet been held, the vessel having been laid up.
