It is intended to carry fuel oil on N^o 6 Tank and fresh water in Tank N^o 9 and the cofferdam bulkheads are to be fitted arranged and built to the scantlings as shown on the plan, duplicate copies of which are being sent under separate cover for approval. The scantlings proposed correspond with those of the existing bulkheads.
