Dear Sir,

We beg to inform you that Messrs. Johan Rasmussen & Co. shipowners at Sandefjord have bought the steamer "MAHRONDA" and decided to convert her into a whale oil factory and to build deep tanks for whale oil below the lower deck in all holds.

As the matter is very urgent and the shipyard desires to order the material for the bulkheads etc. at once, they have requested us to cable you for obtaining approval of the proposed scantlings. We have therefore cabled you today as follows:
