The Second Special Survey No.3 became due in
December, 1937.

This vessel, formerly owned by the Dah Loh
Industrial Co., Ltd., of Shanghai, was reported in January, 1938,
to have been seized by the Japanese Military Authorities, and
action was deferred by the Classing Committee in March last, as
the Japanese Company operating her were unable to furnish any
information as to the carrying out of the survey.

She was subsequently reported to have been sold
to a Greek, Mr. G. Stamatelatos, of Shanghai, and a letter was
addressed to the Society's Kobe Office on the 15th November last
requesting them to inform this gentleman, and also the Japanese
operators, that unless the overdue Special Survey were completed
by the expiration of the year of grace, the vessel's class would
be expunged from the Register Book without further notice.

A letter, dated the 12th ultimo, has now been
received from the Society's Kobe Office stating that the vessel
is still being operated by the Daido Kaiun K.K., on behalf of
the Japanese Naval Department, and that both they and the
Registered Owner have been informed of the contents of the
Secretary's letter of the 15th November last.

The year of grace expired at the end of
last month.

The Classing Committee had the case before



them on Friday, the 6th instant, when, in the absence of any stated arrangements for carrying out the overdue Special Survey, they decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line () indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the interested parties have been informed accordingly.
