S. Reverting to your memorandum of the 22nd July last respecting the steamer "DAH LOH", I have to acquaint you it now appears from a communication received from the Piraeus Surveyors that although the vessel has not yet been registered at a port in Greece she is sailing under a Provisional Certificate and is now named "KARAVADOS". No information whatever can be obtained regarding the Second Special Survey No.3, which has not yet been commenced, and I am instructed by the Classing Committee to request that you will kindly arrange for the Shanghai Surveyors to inform the Registered Owner, viz:- G. Stamatilatos, 55, Yuen Ming Yuen Road, Shanghai, that unless the overdue survey is completed by the expiration of the year of grace at the end of next month, her class will be expunged from the Register Book without further notice. It may be that you will also have an opportunity to inform the Japanese operators accordingly.
