The Second Special Survey No.3 became due on this vessel in December 1937, and as the result of a general examination by the Society's Surveyors at Antwerp in that month, the Committee agreed to a proposal by the Owners to defer this inspection until sometime within the year of grace.

It was subsequently arranged to submit the vessel to inspection at Shanghai in December for examination of the thrust block, a limit on which expired at the end of that month; but on the 28th December the Owners wrote to the Shanghai Surveyor to the effect that as the expenses of continuing the vessel's class would be too heavy, they had decided not to submit her for Special Survey.

The Year of grace expired at the end of December, and after careful consideration, the Classing Committee, who had the case before them on Friday, the 3rd instant, decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line () indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the Society's Surveyor at Shanghai has been requested by cablegram to inform the Owners accordingly.
