In reply to your letter of the 12th inst. regarding the steamer "Frieda" I beg to state that the size of the frames in the engine and boiler space is 7" x 3.45" x 3.45" x .45" channels.

The bulkhead on frame No. 97 is fitted as originally shown on the approved plan, but the owners stated that they did not wish a record of a watertight bulkhead in this case.

Section 49 of the Rules has been complied with, and the oil fuel tank has been tested as required by the Rules.

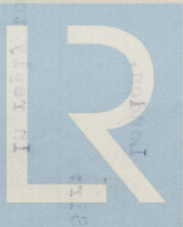
