With reference to the Glasgow first entry reports Nos 39127 and 39128 on Messrs. Babcock & Wilcox Boilers Nos. 408/9 for "N" Type vessels building at Belfast by Messrs. Harland & Wolff, I have now to inform you that the Society's Surveyors at that port report that these boilers have been fitted into the Steamers "PHILADELPHIAN" and "NEW BRIGHTON" respectively.

An account has been rendered to the Ministry of Shipping for the fees for the survey during construction of the boilers at the makers' works, which in each case, amount to £36:6:6, and the amount in question having now been paid your account has been credited with these fees, viz:- a total of £72:13:0, which I shall be glad if you will kindly note and see that the necessary entries are now passed through your Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.
