
Dear Sir:-

We are in receipt of your letter dated April 21st. regarding First Entry Reports Nos. 782 and 789 on the "CANADIAN IMPORTER", and "CANADIAN EXPORTER" respectively.

We beg to inform you that the butts of "A" and "B" Strakes of outside plating are as stated in the above mentioned reports, and a copy of a letter received from New York to the Builders in connection with same is herewith enclosed. The breadth of these strakes as fitted is 93" inches, and rivets attaching same to frames are spaced 5-7/8" inch centres. The stiffeners on bulkheads at frames Nos. 46 and 142 are 10" x 3 1/2 x 32.1 lbs. bulb angles, the dimensions as given on reports is an error on my part, which I trust you will kindly correct.
