Enclosed please find Reports Nos. 889, and 890 covering condition and docking survey on S. S. "CANADIAN IMPORTER", also report on machinery, Report No. 890 covering three damages to hull, and examination of chain cable.

In my report on equipment it is stated that the certificates of anchors and chain cable are stated to be in the Owner's Offices at Ottawa. It is found that the certificates covering equipment of several of the Canadian Government Merchant Marine owned vessels are not in all cases kept on board the steamers, nor are they obtainable from the Company's Offices at this Port, and it would be of assistance if the Owners be requested to have these certificates placed on their various steamers. I may say that this matter has been taken up with the Owner's Representative, who has not been able to obtain these certificates up to this time.
