Reverting to my letter of the 24th inst., I have to state I am now advised by Mr. Edwards that Mr. Blackett proceeded to Vancouver as arranged, and in conjunction with himself, surveyed this vessel whilst lying afloat and unloading.

An examination was made of the ballast and pumping arrangement, also of the decks and shell plating externally, and it is stated as far as could be seen everything was found in order.

The unloading is proceeding and it is understood that the vessel will be drydocked after completion of same, in about a week's time, when Mr. Blackett has arranged to again visit Vancouver and make a more extensive survey.
