Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamers "BALAVIA MARU", "CHICAGO MARU", "HANG-S MARU", "MEXICO MARU" and "SURABAYA MARU", I beg to acquaint you that a copy of your letter of the 14th ultimo, intimating your intention not to maintain the classification of these vessels, addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Kobe, has been forwarded to this Office.
