Gentlemen,

M. I have to acquaint you that from a first entry report received from the Society's Surveyors at Rotterdam it appears that the S.S. "SAINT MICHEL", built by Messrs. N.V. Werf De Noord, is proceeding to your port where her machinery is to be fitted by Messrs. Earle's Shipbuilding & Engineering Co. Ltd.

To complete the survey on the hull the tunnel top plating requires to be riveted and caulked, the engine and boiler casing to be riveted up, and pillars to be fitted in the engine room where practicable.

I shall be glad if you will give the case the necessary attention and on completion forward a report on form 8 for the information of the Committee with a view to the classification of the vessel.
