Nature of Survey First entry

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee the Hull Surveyors should be informed that this vessel is proceeding to their port, where her Machinery is to be fitted by Messrs. Earles Shiping and Engineering Co. Ld., and that in order to complete the survey on the hull the tunnel top plating requires to be riveted and caulked, the Engine and Boiler Casing to be riveted up, and pillars to be fitted in the Engine room where practicable.

They should be requested to give the case the necessary attention, and on completion of the work forward a report on Form 8 with a view to the classification of the vessel.
