A partial General Examination was held but this required to be completed by the internal examination of the oil tanks.

Action has been deferred on this account from time to time.

The Admiralty now write to the effect that when the vessel is no longer required to be used as a storage hulk, she will be offered for sale and from the reports regarding her condition it is most unlikely that she will be suitable for use other than as a hulk.

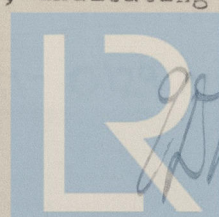
In these circumstances it is not desired to retain her classification.
