Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 5th instant
S. respecting the steamers "PLEIADON", "SCOPAS", "SOHEM" and
"SPIRILA", and having submitted the cases for the consideration
of the General Committee at their meeting today, I am directed
to acquaint you that, in view of your intimation, instructions
have been given for the characters of these vessels to be
withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...)
inserted in lieu thereof, in each case, indicating withdrawal
of class at Owners' request.

I would add that, on the assumption that these
vessels are being retained as storage hulks for the present,
it is proposed to delete from column 3 in the Register Book
the words "under Modified Survey", whilst retaining the words
"now used for storage purposes", or alternatively to delete
the whole of this notation and to substitute the words "Now
used as fuel oil storage hulks", in accordance with the
description contained in your letter of the 4th May last,
and I shall be glad to be favoured with your remarks in
regard thereto.
