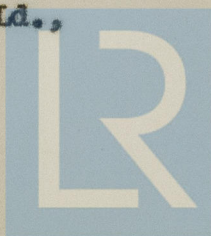
I may add that a cablegram has today been despatched to the Piraeus Surveyors conveying this decision and requesting them to inform the Owners accordingly.
