With reference to my letter of the 2nd instant respecting the steamer "TASSIA", ex "Majestic", and to your cablegram of yesterday's date, as per translation herewith, I have to acquaint you that the Committee, at their meeting today, decided that they were unable to accede to the Owners' request in this case, but must require the full requirements of the 3rd Special Survey No.2 to be complied with before the vessel proceeds to sea, otherwise she will lose her class.
