Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that as arranged in my letter of the 3rd instant, the case of the steamer "TASSIA" ex "MAJESTIC" was submitted to the Classing Committee at their meeting today. They also had before them a cablegram received this morning from the Society's Surveyors at Piraeus detailing the portions of the survey already held and the repairs recommended, but having regard to the fact that the year of grace allowed for the Third Special Survey No.2 has already been considerably exceeded, they regret they are unable to accede to the Owners' request for further extension, and a cablegram has accordingly been dispatched to the Piraeus Surveyors, requesting them to inform the Owners that unless the full requirements of the overdue Special Survey are complied with before the vessel proceeds to sea, she will lose her class.
