Dear Sir,

As requested by your letter of the 18th inst respecting the cylinders of the S.T. "AVANT GARDE" Amos & Smiths No. 3185, I beg to forward my journal and list of dates regarding this No. The list of dates are as follows:-

June. 22,29. July. 6,7,26,. Aug. 12,25,26,28. Sept. 2,10,16,20, 31,. Oct. 4, Nov. 16,19,20,25. Dec. 2,4,9,23. Feb. 9,16.

The special dates On which the cylinders were examined are as follows, July 26th, Aug. 25th, 26th, and sept 16th.

I may further state that about this time Messrs. Amos & Smiths had a large amount of trouble with bad castings in their foundry, one of cylinders in question being the 4th cast before it was accepted. It may be noted that Messrs. Carraghan & Maceand held a special survey on cylinders made by Messrs Amos & Smith, for Messrs. McKie and Baxter Gowan, Glasgow, previous to this, I also called in Mr Harbottle regarding these bad castings as noted in my journal Oct. 8th, and Sept 13th, 1920 for No. 3186 a sister set of machinery. and may state that Messrs Amos & Smith's did all they could do remedy the trouble they
