We regret to report that the L.P. cylinder for the above has turned out slightly defective in the bore, being porous for a short distance, but the material adjacent to the porosity is perfectly sound, and we do not think this is any detriment to the cylinder, further the cylinder has stood the ~~wa~~ water test, Lloyds however, do not wish to accept the cylinder unless the Owners are agreeable and we shall therefore be glad to know when a representative of the Owners is likely to be in this country.

To minimise delay we are using ~~in~~ the L.P cylinder for the vessel 742 (3186).
