Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 3rd instant making enquiries as to the scale of fees current in the United States with particular reference to the case of your motor tanker "WELLFIELD".

In reply I have to say that as set forth in the Society's printed Rules, all fees for surveys held at ports outside the United Kingdom are based upon the services rendered and the custom of the port.

You will appreciate, of course, that the maintenance of Surveyors at ports in America involves much higher costs than in this country but if, after this explanation, you still wish the case under review to be taken up with our New York Office, I shall be prepared to do so on application.
