Dear Sirs,

I was duly favoured with your letter of the 9th instant enclosing a plan in triplicate showing the poop front stiffening proposed for the Motor Ship "WELLFIELD" to meet the requirements of the Load Line Convention, 1930, and with regard thereto I have pleasure in stating that the arrangements as shown and amended on the plan are such as will be approved to meet the above Convention requirements.

It is noted that the bunker on the after side of the poop front bulkhead is at present full of oil, and it will not be possible, therefore, to rivet the horizontal stiffener. In these circumstances the stiffener should be welded to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors.

Two copies of the plan in question are returned herewith, and the remaining copy is being retained for reference.
