Further to our letter of 4th instant, the main contract for the hull repairs of this vessel has been placed with Messrs. Smith's Dock Co.Ltd., North Shields, and whilst in progress we are taking the opportunity of lengthening the vessel by 24'-3" in accordance with the plans approved by you.

To conform with the requirements due to the increase in equipment numeral, the third bower anchor will be replaced by one weighing 63 cwts. with an additional 15 fathoms of cable.

It is also proposed to fit a steel watertight hatch cover on the top of the trunkway to dry hold to conform with the requirements of the International Load Line Convention, 130.

Other details of the work will be communicated to your local Surveyors in the usual manner.
