I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 4th instant respecting the repairs which are now being carried out to the Twin Screw Motorship "WELLFIELD" and note that you propose to take this opportunity of carrying out the Special Survey No.2 which in the ordinary course becomes due in March, 1932, and to which proposal there is no objection.

As regards the question of the lengthening of the vessel by 24' 3" I would take this opportunity to confirm that plans have been submitted by Messrs. Curchin & Watson which have received the Committee's approval, but it noted from your remarks that it has not yet been definitely decided to proceed with this scheme.
