S. I beg to acquaint you that the Society's surveyors at Kobe have forwarded to this Office a copy of your letter to them of the 15th December last, respecting the cases of your steamers "NEKKA MARU", "UBSURI MARU" and ^Ams^Borship "TYOZYO MARU", from which it is noted that you no longer desire to maintain the classification of these vessels with this Society.

In the circumstances the Committee, who have had the cases under consideration, have given instructions for the character of each vessel to be withdrawn from the Register Book and Three Dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
