In reply to your classing letter of the 10th inst, regarding the vessel "Nekka Maru", 2028, we have to confirm that the diameter of the pinion shafts at the bearings is 125 m/m and not 100 m/m as given in the report.

We also have to confirm that the above applies to the Sister Vessel "Kitsurin Maru".

It is regretted that the size of the pinion shafts was stated incorrectly in the reports.

With regard to "Tenyo Maru", 2027, we do not appear to have Circular No.1284 in our files and we should therefore be glad if you would kindly forward a copy of this Circular for our information.
