The Boiler Survey became due on the Steamer "BOSTON MARU" at the end of last month. No survey is due on the Steamer "SYOGEN MARU".

In December last the Society's Surveyors at Kobe forwarded a copy of a letter which they had received from the Owners announcing their decision to withdraw from the Society's classification the vessels of their Fleet as their next Government Surveys became due.

This decision becomes operative in respect of these two vessels during the present month, and the Classing Committee to whom the cases were submitted on Tuesday, the 13th instant, accordingly decided to give instructions for their characters to be withdrawn from the Register Book and Three Dots (. . .) inserted in lieu thereof in each case, 6,39 indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
