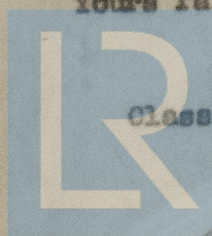
I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Survey Piraeus have forwarded to this Office your letter of the 21st ultimo, addressed to them, from which it is noted that it is not your intention to submit your steamer "ASSIMI" to Third Special Survey No.2 required for maintenance of her classification in the Society's Register Book.

The Committee have asked me to call your attention to the fact that when the vessel was taken over by you during the early part of the present year in this Country, the class was maintained on the understanding that you would carry out the requisite repairs to the boilers, draw the tailshaft, and submit her for general examination of hull and machinery upon arrival at Piraeus, and as it now appears you are not prepared to adhere to this arrangement, they have had no option but to give instructions for the vessel's character to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line denoting non-compliance with the Rules.
