Maschinenfabrik Augsburg-Nürnberg A.G. attend their Works on various dates for the purpose of surveying during construction a 7200 B.H.P., 2 stroke cycle, double acting heavy oil Engine, designated No. 330590 having 7 cylinders 700 mm. diameter and 1200 mm. stroke, type D7Zu70/120, intended for driving the main propelling machinery of Messrs. Harima Zesensho Dock Co. No.179.

This Engine and its accessories have been constructed and tested in accordance with the Society's Rules. The Engine has been tested under full power in the shop and found to work satisfactorily. The working pressure in the cylinders not to exceed 45 atm.


