The Second Special Survey No. 1, which became due on this vessel in July, 1938, has only been partly held, and to complete the same the crossbunker requires to be examined and No. 2 double bottom tank in way tested and the port reserve bunker under Bridge to be examined; also 15 fathoms of chain cable to be supplied to replace a worn length.

At the Owners special request the Classing Committee agreed in August last to the completion of this inspection standing over until the present month so as to coincide with a Government survey, but the Owners now state that "owing to certain circumstances" they have decided to withdraw the vessel from the Society's classification.

The Year of grace expired in July last, and as the Owners have failed to bring the vessel under survey as arranged, the Classing Committee, who had the case before them on Tuesday, 21st instant, decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line (11, 39) indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
