The figures have been centre punched, thus  and further all samples are stamped:- A.H.

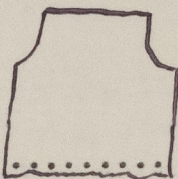
The samples having a crack edge (Nos.2,4,6,8, A,B,C & D), this crack edge has been marked by centre

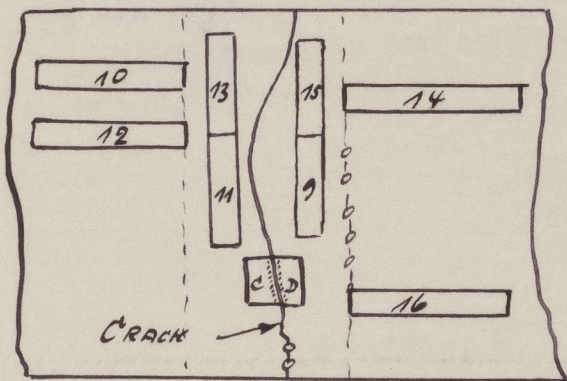

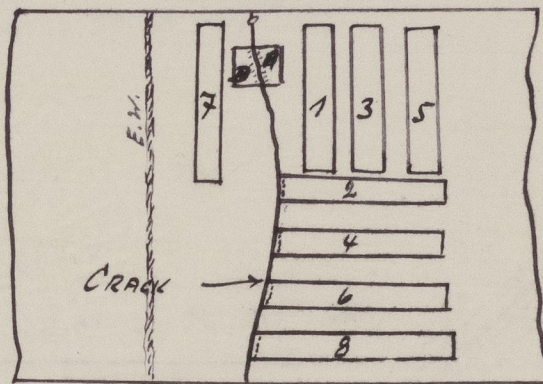
