With reference to your letter H of the 10th November, 1943 and Galveston Report No. 4455 on the steamer "Manuel Arnus" we have to say that the proposed Re-classification, Alterations and Damage Repairs have been cancelled.

The turbines, gearing and auxiliaries have been partly broken and sold as scrap, and the hull has been temporarily patched and towed away by the U. S. Army for a purpose not yet disclosed.

A bill for \$150.00 and \$12.00 expenses, together with a statement on Rpt. 10 of examinations made has been sent to the War Shipping Administration. The statement on Rpt. 10 is required by the W. S. A. Accountant's department for their records.
